## **CARN REVIEW OFFERED AT SEABROK HOUSE**

**Seabrook, NJ**— Seabrook House, along with Southern New Jersey Perinatal Cooperative and the Garden State Chapter of the International Nurses Society on Addictions are teaming up to offer Certified Addictions Registered Nurse (CARN) Review training for area nurses on Saturday, April 27<sup>th</sup>, 2013 on Seabrook's campus in Bridgeton, New Jersey.

The participants who complete the program will be awarded 6.25 nursing contact hours by the Southern New Jersey Perinatal Cooperative. The training starts at 8:00 a.m. and ends at 3:45p.m. on Saturday. Lunch will be provided.

"Seabrook House is excited to be the host for the CARN review program because as a leading addiction treatment facility we realize the need for qualified nurses to work more effectively with the Addicted patient. This will happen by better understanding Addiction medicine." said Stephanie Loebs, Director of Medical Services at Seabrook House. "This training will help prepare attendees to pass the Certified Addictions Registered Nurse exam and increase the opportunities of nurses looking to work in the treatment field and to work more effectively with Addicted Patients."

According to Loebs, the objectives of the review are to teach nurses more efficient way to prepare for the CARN exam; discuss assessment and treatment for major classes of abused substances; review assessments and treatments for co-occurring disorders and learn about substance abuse in pregnancy.

The fee for this training is \$20 for Garden State Members on IntNSA and \$35 for non members. Checks should be made out to Garden State Chapter of IntNSA. The registration deadline is April 23, 2013.
